I am pleased to announce the second call for Faculty Enhancement Opportunity (FEO) Award applications. Applications will be due this Fall for awards in Spring and Summer, 2010. This project is a part of President Machen's efforts to support and enhance professional development opportunities for the faculty.

The University offered FEOs to the in-unit faculty on the same basis as last year, and under the same conditions as for faculty out of the unit. At this point, UFF has not agreed to allow in-unit faculty to participate. We will continue to bargain in hopes FEO will be available to in-unit faculty for the Spring application cycle.

Applications must be reviewed at the unit level. Those endorsed at the unit level will be forwarded to the University-level committee that will review the applications and recommend awards to the Provost.

The final signature page can be faxed to the Academic Affairs Office c/o Ellen Sattler at 392-8735. Awards will be made this fall for FEOs effective Spring/Summer 2010.
